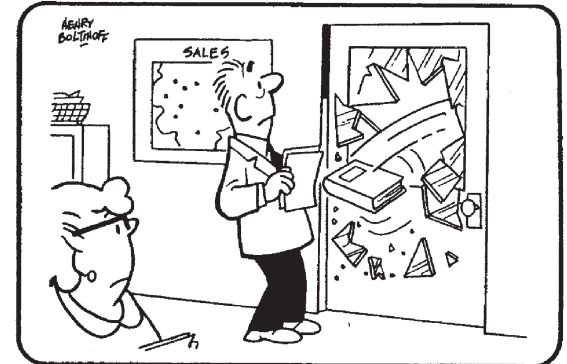

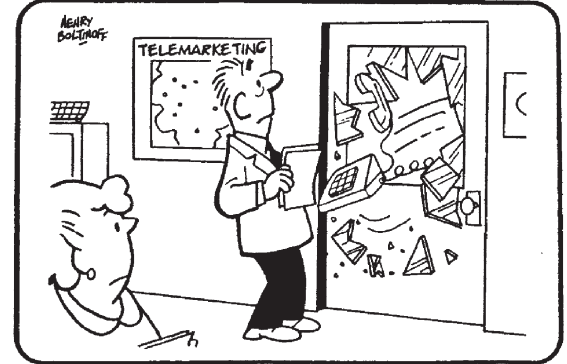

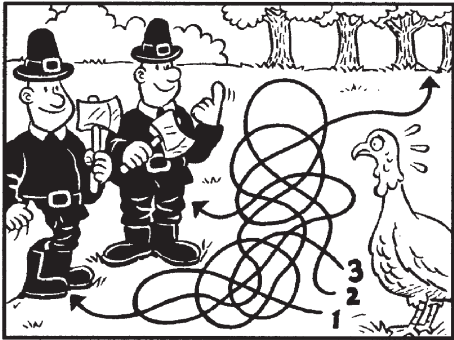

THAT'S A POKER FACE?

4. HINT, HILT, HILL, TILL, TELL.
5. MIME, MILE, TILE, TALE, TALK.
